Religious Education

Intent

To recognise, respect and celebrate the diversity of religious and non-religious views within communities

To engage children in questions which religious views address so that they develop an understanding and reflect upon their own personal views.

To motivate and enthuse pupils in their learning and make links with PSHE and British Values.



Implementation

To introduce ideas through key questions which encourage critical thinking skills and personal reflection on growing subject knowledge alongside nurturing spiritual development.

Knowledge organisers used to support and consolidate learning.

Strong links with local churches & Derby Open Centre to deliver workshops.

Impact

For pupils to develop their knowledge of religious and non religious views and commit to long term memory, measured by discussion, display and end of challenge assessments.

To be able to access KS3 learning.

To use opportunities of personal reflection to develop their own personal views.

Display, recall of experience and end of challenge assessments
