
volcano – A volcano is a rupture in the crust of the Earth, that allows hot lava, volcanic ash, and gases to escape from a magma chamber below the surface. Pacific Ring of Fire- is a ring of volcanoes around the Pacific Ocean capital city- primary city usually with government buildings. island – is any piece of land that is surrounded by water eruption- an explosion of steam and lava from a volcano magma- the molten or semi-molten natural material from which all igneous rocks are formed.

tectonic plates - are pieces of Earth's crust around 100 km (62 mi) thick. climate- the average weather conditions, particularly temperature and precipitation (any form of moisture that falls to Earth from the atmosphere), experienced in a place month by month.

economy – a country's system of the making and trading of goods and the mon which it generates.

tourist – a person who visits another place for interest and enjoyment.
